






TOP: Solid door with Verta Entrance Handle.

ABOVE: Double Classic door (C35VG) with Verta mechanical entrance set.



Constructed by bonding toughened glass sheets to a rigid aluminium frame, this door really makes an impact.










TOP: Classic Door (C75P) with Sublimation wood finish and Addison handle set.








Villa

Sidelights match the entry door and come in a variety of sizes. They can be on either side or both sides of the door. Design options also extend to the glass which can be clear, tinted or, if privacy is important, they can be frosted or obscure.



The Solid Door offers a more contemporary take on the classic panel doors.







ABOVE: Solid door, 4 panels (S05C) in Viper Green with Schlage Sense S600 Digital Touch Pad Lock.



Sublimation


FMI's sublimation finish technology provides an additional decorative layer on top of powder coating.

Sublimation is a wood-grain finish that creates the look and feel of timber with long-lasting paint-free durability. Unlike real wood, the sublimated wood finish is virtually maintenance free.

Sublimation wood-grain can be used on front doors for an eye-catching entrance to any home.









There is a perception that all glass is the same but in fact, there are very real, basic differences in quality and clarity. FMI has considerable expertise in the field of glass and glass application.
